



Clavier-Werke Presents: Ukulele Classes with Jane Gillman

Originally a Marylander, Jane grew up listening to Appalachian music in one ear and rock n roll in the other. She first braved the stage at age 11, performing Bob Dylan's "Blowin' in the Wind" on the ukulele. The University of Texas brought her to Austin, where, after getting a degree in Anthropology and Folklore, she spent the next 20 years playing in bands. She has released 9 albums (Rounder Records; Compass/Green Linnet) and has toured throughout North America and Europe as a singer/songwriter, band member, musical theatre multi-instrumentalist, and Musical Director. She is currently producing and recording *Bad Dino*, a celebration of traditional American music for kids featuring Austin singers.

Jane's musical philosophy can be summed up in three words: create, collaborate, celebrate! She has been leading band classes and teaching guitar, harmonica, mandolin, dulcimer, ukulele and songwriting for 25 years to folks of all ages.
